1. Celebrate the return of the Chelsea Flower Show

London's most flamboyant event is back, as the Chelsea Flower Show invites horticulturalists of all ages to explore its resplendent gardens. Tasty highlights include an afternoon tea on The Promenade created in partnership with The Dorchester, Champagne picnic baskets curated by Fortnum & Mason, and a pop-up from salad connoisseurs Atis, who launch an inaugural pop-up serving bright, crunchy bowls of goodness for the duration of the show. As the social event of the season, only tickets for certain sessions remain. However, there's plenty to enjoy across the neighbourhood. Chelsea in Bloom brings the beauty of the English garden to London's buzzy streets, as more than 100 businesses, shops and restaurants are adorned with floral displays fitting with this year's theme, *Flowers in Fashion*. Peckish? Swing by The Surprise in Chelsea for a Moatwood Meadow Spritz and feast on plump Puglian burrata and Wye Valley Asparagus, garlicy Cornish lobster, and tangy strawberry Eton mess from the specials.
